Our team of teachers are fully certified in the state of Montana and are considered highly qualified within; early childhood, elementary education and special education.

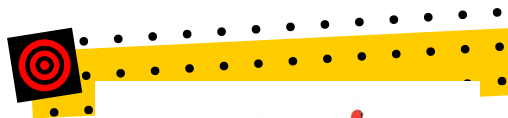

- Independent self-help skills
- Initiates play and conversation with others
- Follows the classroom routine
- Age appropriate communication skills
- Follows simple directions
- Separates easily from peers
- Attends to adult guided activity
