



# Hamilton High Profile



**Demographics:** HHS is a comprehensive, four-year, public high school located in the community of Hamilton, Montana.

Our enrollment is approximately 528 students and we employ 33 certified teachers, two school counselors, two administrators, and several support personnel. HHS has a very low rate of staff turnover.

Approximately 53% of our graduates attend four-year colleges or universities upon graduation, 15% attend a two-year institution, and the rest pursue other training, go to the military, or join the workforce.

**Facility:** Our high school was built in 2000. The school has approximately 168,000 square feet and features five computer labs, a 700 seat performing arts center, and a 4,000 seat gymnasium.

**Accreditation:** HHS provides equal educational opportunity for all students and is accredited by the state of Montana and is accredited by the Northwest Accreditation Commission (NWAC) a Division of AdvancED.

**Curriculum:** HHS offers a balanced curriculum of core academic subjects, career and technical education courses, fine art classes, and health and physical education classes. Typical class sizes are 20-25 students.

**School Day:** 8:15 a.m. – 3:15 p.m. Alternating A day/ B day block schedule with classes meeting every other day for 90 minutes each.

**Grading Scale:**

- A = 90 – 100
- B = 80 – 89
- C = 70 – 79
- D = 60 – 69
- F = 59 and below

**Computation of GPA/Class Rank:** Rank in class is cumulative for grades 9-12 and is not on a weighted scale. The final class rank is determined at the end of the eighth semester.
